Notice of Parish Assembly

The By-Laws require a 10-day advance notice (based on latest By-Laws this can now be electronic) to all members. This bulletin shall serve as that notice. The Assembly shall begin shortly after the coffee hour. Your participation is requested and important for our future.

As provided in our By-Laws, participation in the Assembly requires that one be a member in good ecclesiastical and financial standing at St. Demetrios. This means that one must be Baptized and/or Chrismated in the Orthodox Church; where applicable, married or divorced in the Orthodox Church and lives according to the faith and canons of the Church. One must have completed a Stewardship Pledge Card and must have updated payments.

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGE

CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 31, SECTION 6, PAGE 25

FROM:

SECTION 6: The regular Parish Assemblies of the Parish shall be convened on the third Sunday of May and the Sunday preceding Thanksgiving. In the event that the Parish Council shall determine by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting that the best interest of the Parish would be served by changing the date of a regular parish assembly, the Parish Council Secretary shall notify the membership by not less than ten days prior to the earlier of the regular date or the new date.
